



Admissions Requirements - PN Program

NursingCAS Application:

Your completed online application, High School transcripts, and TEAS scores must be submitted on or before the application deadline. Completed application must be in the *Complete* or *Verified* status on NursingCAS on or before the application deadline.

Required Entrance Exam:

ATI TEAS testing is available at Centra College and remotely via ATI at <https://www.atitesting.com/teas/register>. ATI TEAS scores are broken down into Academic Preparedness Levels. ATI recommends that applicants achieve a level of at least Proficient to enter an LPN program. Because the TEAS test is a comprehensive exam that tests on four different subject areas, so thorough preparation is crucial.

Required Official, final High School Transcripts/GED:

Minimum high school GPA of 2.5. If college credits have been completed, the final course grades and collegiate GPA(s) will be taken into consideration for admission.

Each applicant is considered individually using a holistic review. Meeting minimum admissions requirements does not guarantee admission.

Optional: Co-requisite courses listed below must be completed in the first semester of the PN program or prior to admission. Minimum GPA of 2.5 is required in the first semester PN courses. Please see curriculum guide for more information.

- BIO 145: Human Anatomy and Physiology for the Health Sciences (4 cr hrs) *or*
BIO 142: Human Anatomy and Physiology II (4 cr hrs)
- HLT 143: Medical Terminology I (3 cr hrs)
- PSY 230: Developmental Psychology (3 cr hrs)
- ENG 111: College Composition I (3 cr hrs)
- SDV 101: Orientation to Nursing (1 cr hr)
 - The SDV 101 requirement will be waived for those who have a previous college degree (Associate, Bachelor's, or higher).
