\$250.00 Award to be presented for the Centra Community Service Award

As part of the Centra Community Outreach, an award will be presented to honor a special employee who demonstrates a commitment to supporting the greater Centra service area community through volunteerism.

The award will recognize excellence in service to our local community. The winner will receive a crystal award along with a \$250.00 donation to the community organization or charity of their choice. Their name will also be placed on a plaque that will hang in all four of the community hospital lobbies.

All Nominees will be highlighted on CentraPeople and Centrahealth.com. The Award will be announced at the Spring Diversity Symposium, May of each year

The following criteria will apply:

- A single winner from across the Centra organization will be chosen based on demonstrated level of commitment to service in the community during the prior year as well as their impact on the community.
- Community will be defined as the greater Centra Service area.
- The committee will take into account the service history.
- Winner must have been a Centra employee (this includes all CMG physicians) for 12 months prior to the nomination due date.
- Cannot be for work for which the employee receives direct financial compensation for services.
- Work performed cannot be a direct component of his or her primary job function.
- Nominees may be self-nominated or nominated by a single employee or multiple individual nominations for a single candidate may be submitted.
- Any Centra employee can nominate an employee for this award.
- Service Awards Committee members are not eligible for nomination, but may nominate another employee.
