How Do I Enroll?

Enrollment is simple. Please call 434.315.2890 to set up an appointment. Our PACE team will arrange to meet you at your home to fully explain the program and arrange a visit to the Centra PACE Center.

Fees

Centra PACE is a nonprofit program funded through a unique arrangement with Medicaid and Medicare. If you are eligible for Medicaid and Medicare—or Medicaid only—there may be no fee to join the program or to receive services provided by Centra PACE. If you are eligible for Medicare only, there is a set monthly fee involved. If you do not qualify for Medicare or Medicaid, private pay options are available to enroll in the PACE program.

As a Centra PACE participant, all healthcare services are provided and arranged by your interdisciplinary team. If you receive medical services from an out-of-network provider and/or without prior authorization (with the exception of emergency services), you may be liable for the full cost of those services.

A Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly

PACE is a comprehensive program for adults 55 years of age and older who meet the criteria for nursing facility placement, prefer to stay at home and have an assessment indicating that living at home with the support of the PACE program is a safe alternative.

PACE Mission

The Centra PACE mission is to enhance life for older adults with chronic needs by providing compassionate, quality care and services. PACE strives to achieve this mission by empowering participants to live in their homes and in the community for as long as it is medically and socially safe.

About PACE

PACE is a national program of comprehensive care which promotes independence and the highest levels of functioning while allowing choice and dignity for members and their families.

This is possible because of the comprehensive services delivered by an interdisciplinary team of professionals made up of a primary care physician, registered nurses, a masters level social worker, health aides, transportation personnel, rehabilitation therapists, dietitians and recreation/activity personnel. The team works with participants and their families to develop a tailored plan of care which is monitored closely and updated as needed.

PACE participants can be picked up from their home each morning and brought to the PACE Center. They participate in social activities, eat a hot lunch with friends and receive medical assistance as needed from a dedicated, compassionate care team. At the end of the day, the PACE van takes the participants back home to enjoy family, friends and the surroundings they know and love.

Centra PACE provides families with peace of mind that their loved one is cared for properly and with compassion.

Services

Primary medical care from doctors, nurse practitioners, nurses and therapists is provided at the Centra PACE Center.

PACE Center Hours:

7:00 a.m. – 5:30 p.m., Monday – Friday

OTHER SERVICES INCLUDE:

- Medical care and transportation to and from specialists
- Adult day care
- Hospital care: if hospital services are needed, the PACE interdisciplinary care team will coordinate care

- Prescription medicines
- Vision, hearing and dental care
- Rehabilitation and therapy services
- Durable medical equipment
- Outpatient medical services: lab work, x-rays and other tests will be scheduled as needed
- Mental health care
- Home care and nutritional services
- Respite services
- Support from our interdisciplinary care team
- 24-hour on-call physician services
- Meals
- Personal emergency response
- Wheelchair-accessible transportation
- End of life/palliative care

Eligibility

- Age 55 or older
- Qualify for nursing facility level of care in the state of Virginia
- Able to live safely in the community with the support of PACE
